Scholarship Criteria

I. Eligibility:

- a. Must be a graduating Senior of Bedford High School attending a 2 or 4 year college or university or other trade school or apprenticeship program.
- c. Must have participated in a varsity sport or other extra curricular activity.
- d. Must have demonstrated qualities of strength, courage, perseverance, or generosity.
- e. Must have demonstrated excellent citizenship as a student at Bedford High School.

II. Nomination:

- a. Must be nominated by a teacher, coach, faculty or staff member, peer, or other community member. May not be nominated by a member of his/her own immediate family. Nomination should be a written statement (no more than 2 pages in length) describing the student and why they should be chosen as the scholarship recipient.
- b. Deadline for nomination will be April 13, 2017.
- c. Nominations will be considered and adjudicated by the Executive Board of Bedford Alumni and other scholarship fund representatives. Winner will be chosen by majority vote of the Committee and the Scholarship will be presented at the Bedford High School Graduation Ceremony at the end of each school year.
